If you plan on joining us for morning assembly this Friday, please park in

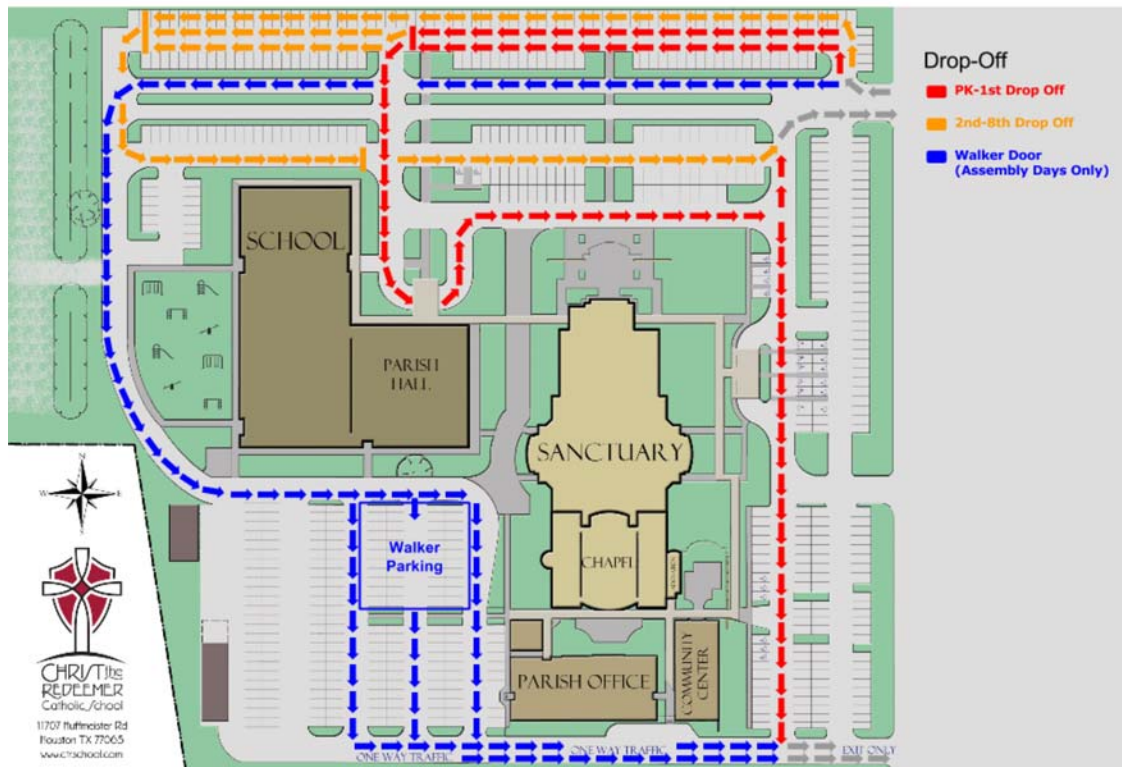
the BACK parking lot. Reminder, we will be celebrating all August birthdays!

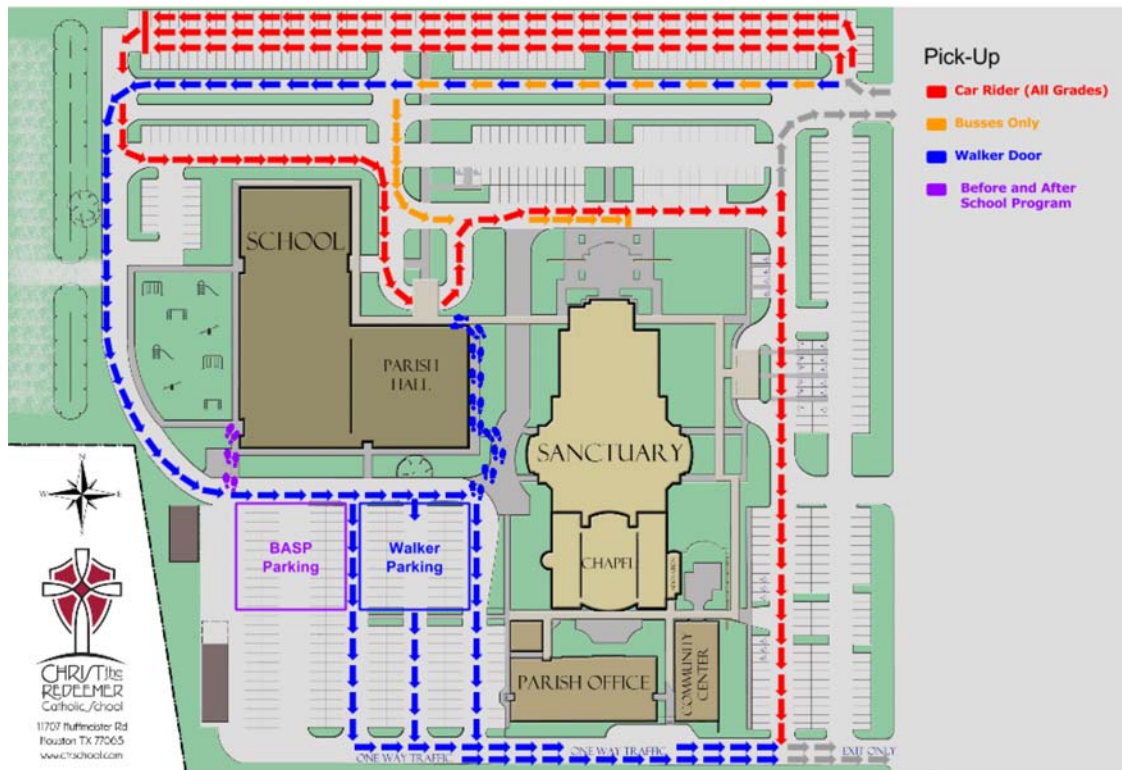
Starting Monday, August 22nd Kinder parents will join the upper grades in using the car line to drop off. **ONLY PK parents may continue to walk their child in.** ALL parents will use the car line starting September 6th.

Parents walking in need to park in the back and walk up to the front door. PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE FRONT PARKING LOT. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO MOVE.

Please review morning and afternoon procedures using the maps below. Please note the following for morning drop off:

- PK-1st should make 2 lines and then turn to form into one
- 2nd-7th should exit the car all along the side of the school building. Please do not wait to pull up to the front. If you child needs extra help, or has a lot of materials that day, feel free to use the lower grade drop off. Teachers are more than happy to assist all your children.
- Please do not block any drive through areas.





So that our students and teachers can get acclimated to their schedules and procedures, we will not allow visitors for lunch until after Labor Day.
