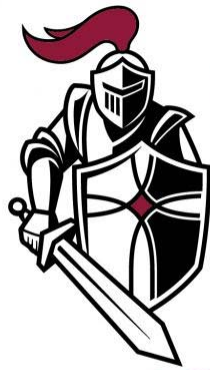

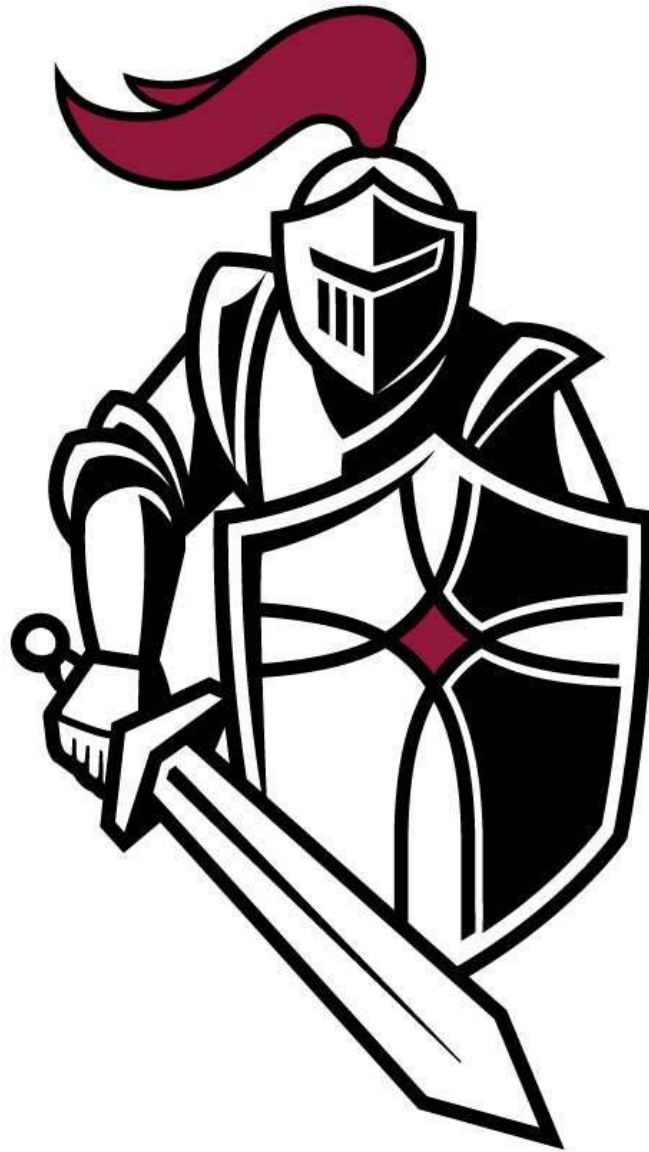

Learning Center at Christ the Redeemer Catholic School

CtRCS provides additional support for students in first through seventh grade through our Learning Center. The Learning Center consists of a Reading Specialist who works predominantly with students classified as struggling readers. Students in the elementary and middle school grades who show academic need through IOWA testing, i-Ready, classroom assessments and teacher referrals will be provided with reading support through small group instruction. All students participating in the CtRCS Learning Center are pulled out of auxiliary classes during the school day.

Mathematic academic support is also provided for students who struggle with math skills in the classroom setting. These students are supported through small group instruction with our campus STREAM Coach.
