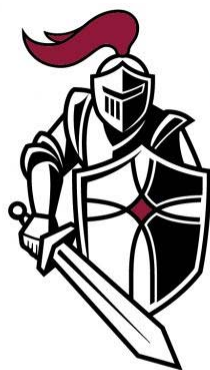

Important Reminders

School closed Monday – Drop off tuition payments by Friday

Parents, please be reminded there is no school on Monday, Sept. 5 due to the Labor Day holiday. Our offices will also be closed; therefore, please drop off all tuition payments by Friday, Sept. 2. Any payment received after the 5th will incur a late fee. Payments are due on the 1st, and we have a five-day grace period to account for holidays, weekends, mail delays, etc. We do not recommend leaving payments in our USPS mailbox. If you are unable to drop your payment off by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 2, we recommend you make your payment online at <http://ctrschool.com/tuition>.

Morning Drop off:

PLEASE remember to be kind and courteous during morning drop off. All vehicles should be taking turns, from left to right. Remember that if you have a student who needs extra assistance, use the car line where teachers are opening the doors, even if they are not in PK-1st grade.

REMINDER:

ALL students, including PK, will be using the car line starting Tuesday.

Afternoon Car Line Reminder:

Genesis will be starting next week. Please be mindful of not pulling all the way down through the parking lot until after 2:15 pm for pick-up. Genesis parents use the far section of the parking lot to park and walk in to pick up their children. Thank you for your understanding!

Books are checked out for one week with a one-week grace period. After two weeks your child will receive a late notice. After three weeks the child will be reminded that their book is still overdue. After a book is out for a month you will be fined \$20 for a late/missing book. Kindergarten students may have one book checked out at a time, and students in grades 1 through 5 may have two books checked out at a time.
