Balances to Close Out 2016-17 and First Round of Tuition Statements for 2017-18

NOTE: Please add registrar@ctrschool.com to your trusted contacts list to ensure you do not miss any communications from the CtRCS Business Office.

Any students with a balance due to close out 2016-17 will receive a statement via email no later than May 17. Please send in all payments as soon as possible, but no later than May 23.

In addition, the first round of tuition statements for 2017-18 will be sent out next week. Please note our system sends out a separate email per student per academic year, so please be on the lookout for multiple emails and review them carefully. The first tuition payment for 2017-18 is due by Thursday, June 1. Our summer office hours are 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Monday – Thursday and 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. on Friday. Please do not leave payments in our mailbox, as they may be mistakenly picked up by the mail carrier. If you are not able to stop by during office hours, please send your check through the postal mail.
